3. If that is how you are called this week, what will it cost you to live that message?
4. Are you willing to pay the price?

Name one concrete way you feel the community of \_\_\_\_\_ is called to live this Gospel message today.

Closing question:

What have you received from this session? Where have you been challenged or affirmed? How can it help you this week?
